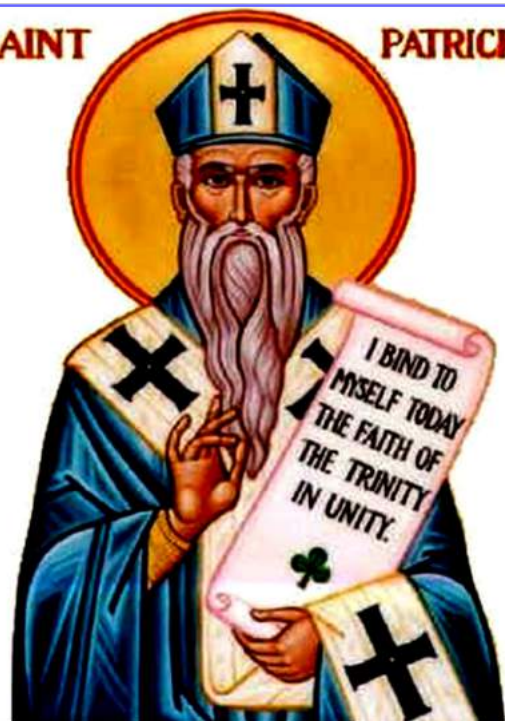

*'Awaken! Remember that God comes!
Not yesterday, not tomorrow, but today, now!
The one true God, "the God of
Abraham, Isaac and Jacob", is not a God who is
there in Heaven, unconcerned with us and our
history, but he is the-God-who-comes.'*¹

The Season of Advent is therefore a season of vigilant waiting, that prepares us to welcome the mystery of the Word Incarnate, who will give the 'Light' to the womb of the Virgin Mary, but essentially this time prepares us not only to welcome this great event but to incarnate it in our lives.

We could say that the true light enters the world through the immaculate womb of Mary but it does not stay there. On the contrary, this light flows out into our dark, obscure, sinful lives to illuminate them, so that we can become the light that illuminates the world.

The Mediterranean Diet is another diet suggested by Dr. Saleh and according to the Mayo Clinic is endorsed by several scientific organizations because it can reduce cardiovascular risks, and even reduce the risks of certain cancers and Alzheimer's disease. This diet focuses on adding more fresh fruits, vegetables, whole grains, legumes and unsaturated fats like olive oil to your daily intake and reducing the amount of red meats and dairy to your diet. This diet also allows you to drink red wine in moderation, suggests eating meals with family and friends, and also strongly suggests increasing your daily physical activity.

The American Heart Association states that "moderate" consumption for wine is no more than 2-4oz glasses per day.

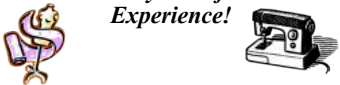

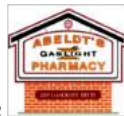
