31st Sunday in Ordinary Time

It is easy to view each other with suspicion or at least a certain guardedness in the modern world. Of course, it's wise to be prudent in our dealings with people. But stewardship calls us to a different outlook towards others. It calls us to approach everyone with an open heart — not through a lens of suspicion, but through the lens of loving hospitality.

This is the attitude of our heavenly Father when He looks upon creation, as we see in our first reading from the Book of Wisdom: "For you love all things that are and loathe nothing that you have made; for you would not fashion what you hate." God's imperishable spirit is in every person because every person is made in God's own image and likeness.

Far deeper than good manners or a superficial exchange of pleasantries, the virtue of hospitality is the outward expression of this way of seeing people as God sees them.

Our Gospel reading from Luke tells the story of how Jesus models this transforming hospitality in His encounter with the tax collector, Zacchaeus. He was not content exchanging a friendly hello with Zacchaeus, so Jesus sought him out of the crowd and insisted on having dinner in his home. This gesture of intimacy and true fellowship was commonplace in that day and culture. Jesus saw the goodness within the man. Our Lord's open and welcoming attitude (His hospitality) called forth this goodness, and as a result, Zacchaeus transformed.

If we are willing to practice Christian hospitality in our daily lives, our families, workplaces, and parish also can be transformed.

31 Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Es fácil mirarse unos a otros con recelo o al menos con cierta cautela en el mundo moderno. Por supuesto, es sabio ser prudente en nuestro trato con la gente. Pero la corresponsabilidad nos llama a una perspectiva diferente hacia los demás. Nos llama a acercarnos a todos con un corazón abierto, no a través de la lente de la sospecha, sino a través de la lente de la hospitalidad amorosa.

Esta es la actitud de nuestro Padre celestial cuando mira la creación, como vemos en nuestra primera lectura del Libro de la Sabiduría: "Porque amas todas las cosas que existen y nada de lo que has hecho aborreces; odio." El espíritu imperecedero de Dios está en cada persona porque cada persona está hecha a imagen y semejanza de Dios.

Mucho más profunda que los buenos modales o un intercambio superficial de cumplidos, la virtud de la hospitalidad es la expresión exterior de esta manera de ver a las personas como Dios las ve.

Nuestra lectura del Evangelio de Lucas cuenta la historia de cómo Jesús modela esta hospitalidad transformadora en Su encuentro con el recaudador de impuestos, Zaqueo. No se contentó con intercambiar un saludo amistoso con Zaqueo, por lo que Jesús lo buscó entre la multitud e insistió en cenar en su casa. Este gesto de intimidad y verdadero compañerismo era común en esa época y cultura. Jesús vio la bondad dentro del hombre. La actitud abierta y acogedora de nuestro Señor (su hospitalidad) suscitó esta bondad y, como resultado, Zaqueo se transformó.

Si estamos dispuestos a practicar la hospitalidad cristiana en nuestra vida diaria, nuestras familias, lugares de trabajo y parroquia también pueden transformarse.
