From Pastor's Desk



As we gather to celebrate the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time, we reflect on the profound themes of calling, glory, and transformation present in today's readings.

In our First Reading from Isaiah (62:1-5), we hear of God's unyielding love for His people, promising a new name and a glorious future. This serves as a reminder that our identity is rooted in God's everlasting embrace.

The Psalm (96:1-2, 2-3, 7-8, 9-10) encourages us to proclaim His marvelous deeds to all nations, urging us to spread the joy of our faith and the glory of the Lord in every corner of the earth.

As we move to the Second Reading (1 Corinthians 12:4-11), St. Paul emphasizes the diverse gifts given to us through the Spirit. Each of us is called to contribute to the Body of Christ, recognizing that our unique talents are meant to serve and uplift one another.

In today's Gospel (John 2:1-11), we witness the first miracle of Jesus at the wedding at Cana, where He transforms water into wine, symbolizing the new life and abundance He brings. This miracle underscores the intimate relationship between the Divine and the human, as we are called to recognize the ways in which God is at work in our lives. Let us carry this message with us this week, embracing our identity in Christ and sharing the good news of His glory with all we meet.
